

We have begun working on the building project at Beaver Lake Camp. We built a new water treatment plant for the property last year. There is clean drinking water in all the buildings on the property, is a complicated and regulated process. We are blessed with a spring that already has very clean water, so the water treatment plant is primarily checking the boxes for the regulators.

The new driveways were built last fall. The loose dirt was removed where the gym will be built. Rock removal has started. The process of moving a small part of the Canadian Shield is difficult, noisy, and slow.

The builders are working on being ready to build the gym this summer and fall. The first major goal is to have the gym under roof by the time snow flies. Pray for that to be accomplished. Pray for safety for the workers. Pray that the funds needed will continue to arrive on time.

We plan to build as the funds are available to take the next steps.


We Partner




PHASE ONE | GYM, LOUNGE, PUBLIC WASHROOMS
















