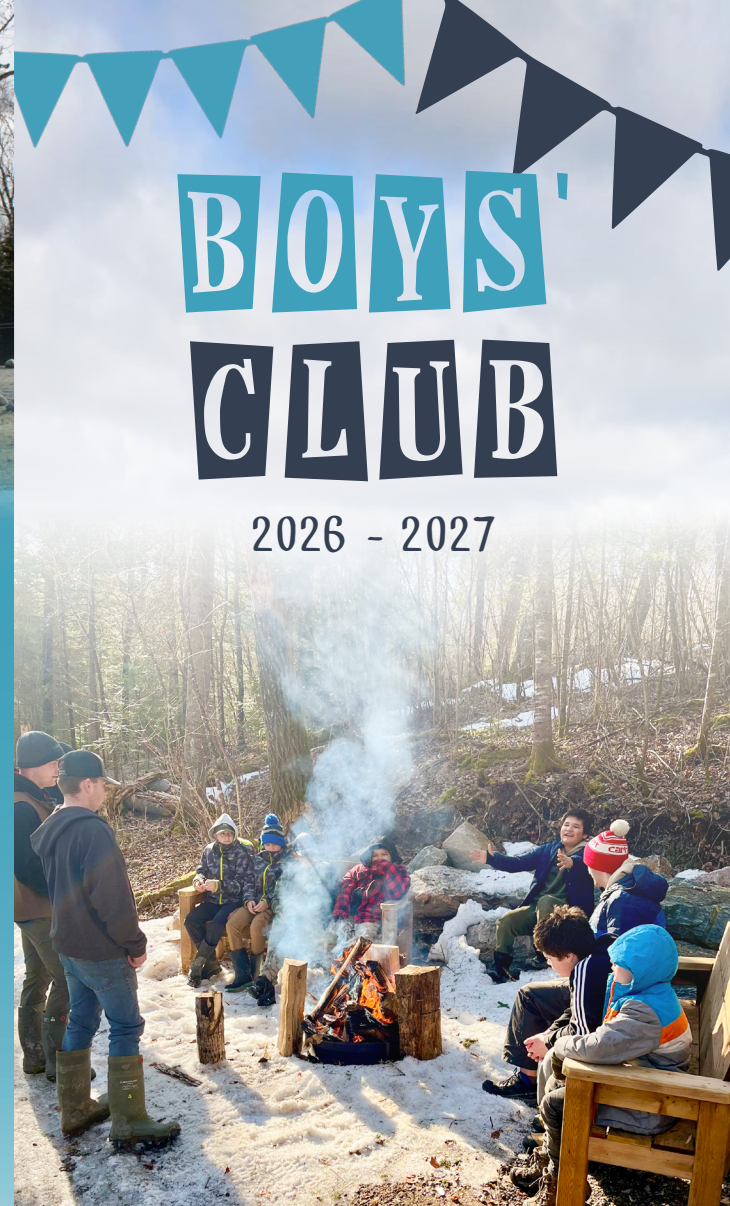

WAIVERS AND CONDITIONS OF REGISTRATION

1. I understand that the Program Manager reserves the right to dismiss anyone who is deemed a danger to the safety and rights of others or who has willfully broken the expectations of the program and BLC.
 2. I understand that possession of non-prescriptive drugs and alcohol is prohibited. If suspected, the Program Manager may conduct a bag search and may lead to immediate dismissal from BLC.
 3. I agree to reimburse BLC for any property damage I/my child may cause.
 4. I understand that while at BLC, I/my child will take part in physical activity including sports and water/land-based activities. Every reasonable effort will be made to accommodate my individual needs and to promote safety in these activities. With physical activity, I recognize the potential for injury or accidents and agree to release Northern Youth Programs, Beaver Lake Camp, and their staff from any liability for any loss or injury while attending BLC.
 5. In the event of experiencing an accident or injury, I give the BLC staff the right to administer necessary medical aid, including non-prescriptive drugs. In the event that I/my child require(s) special medication, x-ray, or treatment beyond that which is possible at BLC, I understand that I am responsible for expenses related to care and transportation.
 6. I give permission to Beaver Lake Camp to use any photographs or videos of myself and my children for promotional purposes. I recognize that BLC will not share these images with any other organization, business, company, or individual.
 7. I also give permission to BLC to collect, file, and store personal information entered on this registration form for BLC purposes. I understand that the privacy policy is available on request.
 8. By signing this form, I acknowledge legal custody over the applicant and/or the legal authority to register my child to attend Beaver Lake Camp Boys' Club.
 9. I give permission for Beaver Lake Camp staff to transport my child to and from Beaver Lake Camp for the purposes of the Boys' Club event.
